SUMMARY OF INSTRUCTIONS

You are on study leave from Wednesday 11th to Friday 20th December 2024. You only need to attend school when you have an exam. It is your responsibility to make sure that you attend your exams and that you are on time. Please speak to a member of the school office staff if you are unable to attend due to health issues, or if you will be late due to unforeseen circumstances (Tel no: 0121 444 3188). You may wish to email Mrs Simmonite, as well, but she will be unable to pick them up first thing in the morning.

All exams start at the beginning of "normal period times"- the only exception is Music on 20th December which will start at 9.00am

All exams take place in the rooms stated, plus other rooms not specified on the timetable, so make sure you look at your own individual timetable or the seating plans (exam notice board - adjacent to R5) to know where you are sitting for each exam. You will not always be in the same room or seat.

Make sure you bring your own stationery- none will be provided.

It is essential that you are outside your designated room 10 mins before the start of your exam. Five minutes before an exam starts a briefing will take place where the necessary instructions will be given. If you attempt to enter the room after this briefing has started, you will be prevented from doing so. The exam will start without you. You will then be given the briefing outside the exam room and only then be allowed to enter the room. Thus, you will lose exam time.

No mobile phones, electronic devices, bags, watches or any smart devices will be allowed into any of the rooms.

If you are found in possession of a mobile phone, electronic device, watch or smart devices in an exam room you will be given a zero for that exam.

If you are found cheating you will be given a zero for that exam.
